Dear Parents

Thank you for your continued support, as we have now entered a national lockdown we need to ensure that we follow social distancing procedures and health and safety procedures. The safety of pupils, staff and parents is of paramount importance. Please support us by following the following guidelines:

Dropping off and picking up your child

- Please ensure that you stay 2m from other parents when waiting for your child to enter school or leave school.
- Only one adult should enter the playground to drop off and pick up pupils.
- Do not park on our car park - this is a significant safety hazard for our pupils

Punctuality

For the protection of staff, parents and children please collect and drop off your children on time. This is very important as we have staggered start and finish times to reduce contact, thereby reducing the risk of infection.

Contacting school

If you need to contact us, we would ask that in the first instance you use email or a phone call. If a meeting is required whilst we are in lockdown, we are likely to request a Zoom meeting or phone meeting.

Coronavirus

Please **do not bring your child to school if they or anyone in your household is demonstrating symptoms of coronavirus.** Instead, please ensure they are tested for the virus. If the test is negative, your child can of course return to school.

Symptoms

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of any of the following:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness. However, **if your child or anyone in your household has any of the symptoms above you should self-isolate at home and get tested to find out if it is safe for your child to attend school.**

Should your child display any symptoms during the school day, we will ring you and ask you to collect them. In the meantime they will be isolated in the medical room.

Individual Pupil Isolating

If your child is isolating but is feeling well, we will provide online learning opportunities. If you do not have a suitable device please let us know as we may be able to lend you a device for the length of their isolation.

Bubble Isolating

If your child's whole bubble is isolating, online learning will be available for your child and the class teacher will start each day with a 10 minute Zoom meeting to introduce the day's learning.
