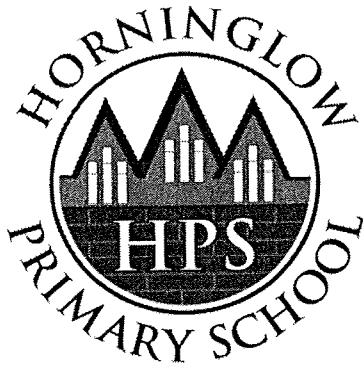

Uniform Policy

Academy Uniform

- Bottle Green Academy sweatshirt or Cardigan with logo
- White polo shirt with or without logo
- Grey trousers or skirt / pinafore (grey shorts in Summer)
- Black shoes with no colour or branding visible (black laces fastened). No training shoes
- Boys grey socks / Girls grey socks or tights

Indoor PE

- Academy white t-shirt with logo
- Black shorts
- Black plimsolls

Outdoor PE

- Academy white t-shirt with logo
- Black shorts or black jogging bottoms
- Training shoes

No extreme hair styles and/or colouring is permitted.

Jewellery and other Adornment

The only items that are considered appropriate for school are watches, and one pair of plain studs or plain sleepers worn in the ears.

Children should be able to remove all jewellery including earrings, for PE and Games or they should not wear them on the day of their PE lessons. Please note that staff are not allowed to remove or look after jewellery for children.

If children are to have their ears pierced then this should happen at the start of the summer holidays to allow the healing time of 6 weeks in order that earrings can then be removed.

The Academy does not approve of the wearing of make up or other jewellery except for cultural reasons, and then only if approved by the Principal.
